



Eligibility Requirements:

- You are a current high school student who is expecting to graduate in 2023, 2024, or 2025.
- You are excited about learning more about leadership and growing as a young professional.

Member Expectations:

- Attend 5 or more Student Leader volunteer events throughout the school year. There will be at least 12 volunteer opportunities offered.
- Fundraise for K9s For Warriors. Fundraising can be completed individually or in conjunction with a school club or sports team. Our fundraising requirements are as follows:
 - Raise at least \$2,000 during the school year. Proceeds from the requirements below count towards this fundraising goal.
 - Host a restaurant night in October 2022
 - Host at least one additional fundraising event
 - Sell at least \$200 in merchandise from the K9s Catalog
 - Sell at least 5 tickets to the Student Leaders Benefit
- Provide regular updates to K9s For Warriors Student Leaders staff about the progress of your club and fundraising event. Respond swiftly to communications coming from our staff.
